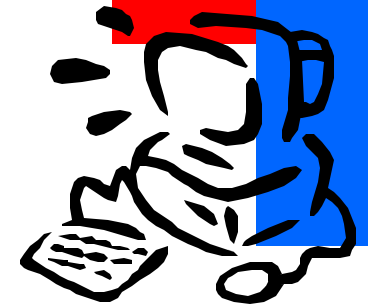

WHAT IS GMIS?

On April 21, 1971, forty data processing practitioners from the United States and Canada met to form Government Management Information Sciences (GMIS). They perceived a need for a tightly knit organization of friends and colleagues who could work together for the common good and share ideas and information. They wanted to be able to discuss strategies, problems and policies with other governmental data processing managers. They believed the sharing of information about the evaluation, acquisition, and installation of hardware, software and communications alternatives would greatly benefit their member agencies.

GMIS membership is comprised of Government agencies, NOT the individuals that make up these organizations. GMIS has grown to over 600 members from 41 states and 6 countries. One agency membership provides the privileges of membership to all employees of the agency. These agencies come from government and educational institutions involved in data processing at all levels of state, county or local government. While member agencies differ in many aspects, they form a homogeneous group with similar interests.

The purpose of GMIS is to provide a forum for the exchange of ideas, information, and techniques; to foster enhancements in hardware, software, and communication developments as they relate to government activities. GMIS fosters assistance and sharing among all levels of government involved in the vastly growing world of technology.

GMIS sponsors the formation of State and/or Regional chapters to enable agencies within a

geographical area to develop close relationships and to foster the spirit and intent of GMIS through cooperation, assistance and mutual support. We invite and encourage you to become a member of this unique group of professionals engaged in all levels of government information management.
